Packing List

All sessions, events, and workshops are casual — stay warm, dry and comfortable!

- If you are in a Woodland Cabin or Adventure Bunkhouse (For Plaza Lodge Rooms, all bedding, pillows, towels supplied.)
 - Sleeping bag or bedding for single bunks or queen beds. Bunks have a simple mattress with a vinyl cover. There are both in the Woodland Cabins, some participants have reserved a queen bed — you know who you are.
 - Pillow
 - You may also want to bring an extra bottom sheet, mattress cover or blanket to put under your bedding.
 - Towel and washcloth
- Be prepared for varied Oregon weather! You will be having fun and learning outdoors!
- Layered clothing, socks, under garments - it will get warm.
- Raincoat/Warm Jacket - and it will get cold, and windy.
- Fleece/Sweaters/Hoodies
- Comfortable shoes

- Water bottle and reusable coffee cup/Hydroflask
- Ear plugs, eye mask
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Camera/Phone

- Hat - for rain, sun, or hiding bed head
- Rubber flip flops for the shower
- Pens and paper, clipboard or notebook to write on
- Electronics and cords, headphones/earbuds, laptop if you wish
- Business cards and organizational materials and brochures to share at our resource tables.
